

Allen Township Zoning Commission

April 7, 2026

Attendance: Meg Powell, Deb Stacy, John Timmerman.

Deb Stacy, ATZC Secretary, read the March 3, 2026 meeting minutes.

24-04-110M John Timmerman moved to approve the March 3, 2026 meeting minutes. Meg Powell seconded the motion. The members voted and the motion passed.

Deb Stacy stated that Clara Pargeon's term for zoning commission expired on March 31, 2026. It was acknowledged that Clara served for two years and her service was greatly appreciated. The township trustees have the responsibility of filling that position. Lucinda Land, Assistant County Prosecutor, was present at the meeting. Cindy stated that Clara could continue in her position until a replacement was secured.

Deb Stacy mentioned that the commission should consider canceling the May 5, 2026 meeting. In April 2025, Cindy Land recommended that the zoning commission not meet for the May 2025 meeting due to the election taking place at the same location. Cindy Land suggested that the same protocol be followed for the May 2026 meeting.

24-04-111M Deb Stacy moved to cancel the May 5, 2026 zoning commission meeting. John Timmerman seconded the motion. The members voted and the motion passed.

The next meeting for the ATZC will be held on June 2, 2026 at 6:30 p.m.

Deb Stacy briefly addressed some zoning misinformation from 2025 and corrected the information: Land is taxed according to use and not how it is zoned; wetlands are protected by federal and state laws and are not impacted by zoning; and burn barrels are not addressed in the zoning resolution.

John Timmerman asked Cindy if the proposed zoning resolution would permit a data center in the township. Cindy stated that a data center would not be permitted.

24-04-112M John Timmerman moved to adjourn the meeting. Deb Stacy seconded the motion. The members voted and the motion passed.
