**THE EXISTING LEVEL 1 IWP COVERAGE LETTER SHALL BE MODIFIED AS FOLLOWS WITH
THE UNDERLINED TEXT ADDED AND THE STRICKEN TEXT REMOVED:**

On December 1, 2025, the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (Ohio EPA) received a pre-activity notice (PAN) for coverage under the OHIO GENERAL PERMIT FOR FILLING CATEGORY 1 AND CATEGORY 2 WETLANDS (general permit). In the PAN, you requested to impact 0.24 acre of one forested Category 2 wetland and 0.18 acre of two non-forested Category 2 1 wetlands for the purpose of constructing a data center located in the City of Sidney in Shelby County (40.266278, -84.194246). As compensatory mitigation for the aforementioned impacts, you provided proof of reservation of 1.0 forested credits at the Norton Run Mitigation Bank.

Ohio EPA has reviewed your request and subsequent information received on December 10, 2025, has determined that it is complete and meets the PAN requirements for coverage under the general permit.

Please familiarize yourself with the general permit (see link below). It contains requirements and prohibitions with which you must comply. In particular, please be aware of permit condition Part VI.F. requiring mitigation credit proof of purchase within 30 days of receipt of this authorization (12/16/2025). All notifications and reports regarding coverage under the Level One Isolated Wetland Permit shall be uploaded using the "View Compliance" action for

the corresponding permit through the 401 service in the Ohio EPA eBusiness Center.

OHIO GENERAL PERMIT FOR FILLING CATEGORY 1 AND 2 ISOLATED WETLANDS

Additionally, please be aware that as per ORC §6111.022(E) and Part V of the general permit, the proposed filling of the isolated wetland(s) must be completed by December 16, 2027. If you do not complete the filling within this time, you must submit a new pre-activity notice to Ohio EPA.

THIS CONCLUDES ALL THE MODIFICATIONS TO THE EXISTING LEVEL 1 IWP COVERAGE LETTER.

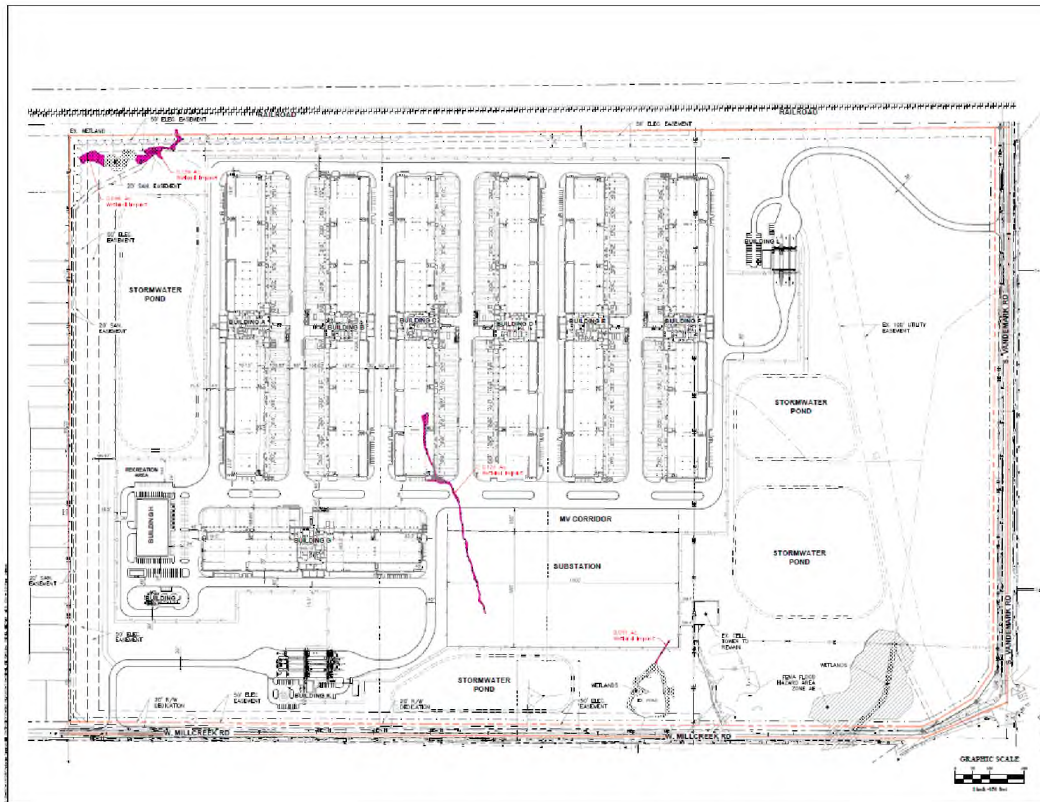


Figure 1: Project Impact Map
